

The Council owned car park, Pioneer Place, is located within the retail precinct of Katoomba. Pioneer Place has been identified as a public facility that requires improvement in the areas of pedestrian and vehicular movement, access and urban design.

Council is undertaking an exercise in identifying and investigating the form these improvements might take. This investigation will culminate in the preparation of a master plan designed to address the issues currently associated with Pioneer Place and to encourage where possible, active frontages, improved public realm and a safer and more accessible environment.

Preparation of a master plan will occur in two phases:

Stage 1 focuses upon a 'prioritised area'. The prioritised area incorporates the upper and lower tiers of parking between Waratah St and the vehicular access way between Katoomba Fair and the Coles/Kmart complex.

Stage 2 will incorporate the broader Pioneer Place public parking facility.

Stage 1 of the program is largely complete. With input from both internal and external key stakeholders, a draft master plan for Stage 1 has been developed. Council is now seeking input from the broader community. Details on where to view the master plan and how to make a submission can be found on the back of this brochure.

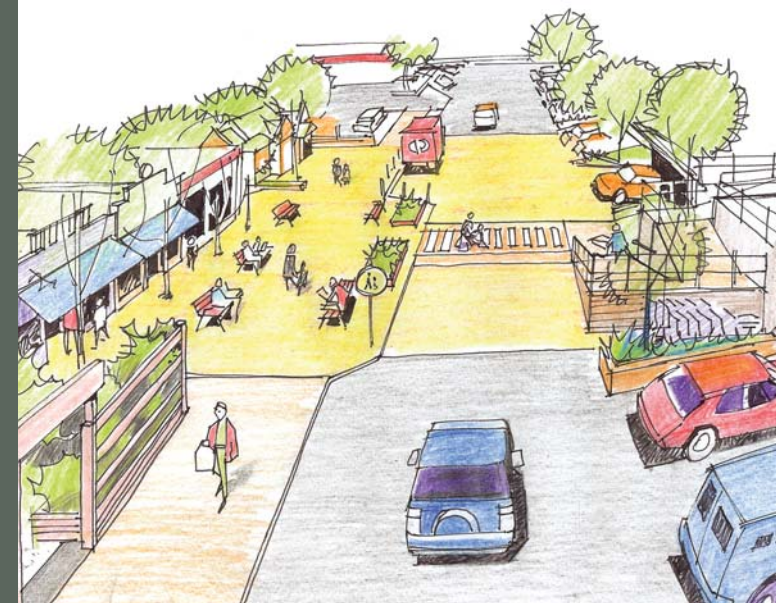
